

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SCHOOL ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

The goal of internet usage is to make the resources available by this service to both the students and the staff. The service will promote educational excellence in school by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication and will promote a globally linked classroom. With this privilege comes a set of rules for acceptable behavior.

- **Educational Purpose:** Activities that are acceptable on the Immaculate Conception network include classroom activities, career development and research activities.
- **Internet Access:** Students may have access to the Internet resources through the classroom or computer lab.
- **Procedures:**
 1. **Personal Safety and Personal Privacy:** You will not post personal contact information about yourself or any other person. Personal contact information includes your address, telephone, school address, etc. This information may not be provided to an individual, organization, or company, including websites that solicit personal information.
 2. **Respecting Resource Limits:** You will use the system only for educational, career development activities or discovery activities. Check with the teacher before downloading files. You will not intentionally modify files, other data, or passwords belonging to other users.
 3. **Plagiarism:** You will not plagiarize work that you find on the Internet. Plagiarism is taking the ideas or writing of others and presenting them as if they were yours.
 4. **Inappropriate Access to Material:** You will not use the Immaculate Conception network to access material that is profane, obscene, or designated for adults only. If you mistakenly access inappropriate information, you should immediately tell your teacher.
 5. **Downloading Files:** Internet users are not permitted to display, download, or save non-school related files (including: media players, MP3 files, Internet email, instant messages, games or videos).
 6. **Care of equipment:** Tampering with the equipment, altering programs without authorization, or reconfiguring any part of a computer is forbidden.

Violating the Acceptable Use Policy may result in one of the following:

- a. Restricted network access
- b. Loss of network access
- c. Disciplinary or legal action
